

SYSTEMCORP EMBEDDED TECHNOLOGY SOFTWARE LICENSE AGREEMENT

These license terms are an agreement between SystemCORP Embedded Technology Pty Ltd and you and/or your company. Please read them. They apply to SystemCORP Embedded Technology software applications including the media on which you received it, if any. The terms also apply to any SystemCORP Embedded Technology

- updates,
- supplements,
- Internet-based services, and
- support services

for this software, unless other terms accompany those items. If so, those terms apply.

By using the software, you accept these terms. If you do not accept them, do not use the software.

As described below, installation or use of the software also operates as your consent to the transmission of certain standard computer information during validation, automatic download and installation of certain updates, and for Internet-based services.

If you comply with these license terms, you have the rights below for each license you acquire.

1. INSTALLATION AND USE RIGHTS.

- a. **Use.** You may install and use copies of the software on PC or Laptop Computers where you have paid the license fees and received the key for that particular computer's "Hardware Fingerprint".
- b. **Separation of Components.** The components of the software are licensed as a single unit. You may not separate the components and install them on different devices.
- c. **Included SystemCORP Embedded Technology Programs.** The software may contain other SystemCORP Embedded Technology programs. The license terms with those programs apply to your use of them.

2. VALIDATION.

- a. The software may cause the operating system software to conduct validation checks of your operating system software from time to time, depending upon your specific operating system.
- b. Validation verifies that your computer's operating system has been activated and is properly licensed. Validation also permits you to use certain features of the software or to obtain additional benefits.
- c. If a validation check is performed, the software will send information about the software and your operating system software to SystemCORP Embedded Technology. This information may include the versions of the software and operating system software, and/or other hardware/software specific machine configuration. This is referred to as the "Hardware Fingerprint" SystemCORP Embedded Technology does not use the information to identify or contact you. **By using the software, you consent to the transmission of this information.**
- d. If, after a validation check, your Hardware Fingerprint is found not to be properly licensed, the software you are installing may be disabled, or the functionality of the application software may be affected, depending upon your specific Hardware Fingerprint..

- e. You may only obtain updates or upgrades for application software from SystemCORP Embedded Technology or authorized sources. For more information see <http://www.systemcorp.com.au>.
- 3. INTERNET-BASED SERVICES.** SystemCORP Embedded Technology provides Internet-based services with the software. Except as otherwise noted in materials accompanying a service, it may change or cancel them at any time.
- a. **Consent for Internet-Based Services.** Some software features connect to SystemCORP Embedded Technology or service provider computer systems over the Internet. You will not receive a separate notice when they connect. **By using these features, you consent to the transmission of information.** SystemCORP Embedded Technology does not use any information other than to identify the specific computer running the licensed software (i.e. this information is used to create the software 'key').
- Computer Information. The following features use Internet protocols, which send to the appropriate systems computer information, such as your Internet protocol address, the type of operating system, browser and name and version of the software you are using, and the language code of the device where you installed the software. SystemCORP Embedded Technology uses this information to make the Internet-based services available to you.
- SystemCORP Embedded Technology Updates. By installing the software on your PC or Laptop computer, you also agree to receive updates from SystemCORP Embedded Technology.
 - Error Reports. This software may automatically send error reports to SystemCORP Embedded Technology that describes which software components had errors.
 - Automatic Updates. This software may have an Automatic Update feature. SystemCORP Embedded Technology may change or cancel it at any time.
- 4. SCOPE OF LICENSE.** The software is licensed, not sold. This agreement only gives you some rights to use the software. SystemCORP Embedded Technology reserves all other rights. Unless applicable law gives you more rights despite this limitation, you may use the software only as expressly permitted in this agreement. In doing so, you must comply with any technical limitations in the software that only allow you to use it in certain ways. You may not
- disclose the results of any benchmark tests of the software to any third party without SystemCORP Embedded Technology's prior written approval;
 - work around any technical limitations in the software;
 - reverse engineer, decompile or disassemble the software or software key;
 - make more copies of the software than specified in this agreement or allowed by applicable law, despite this limitation;
 - publish the software for others to copy;
 - rent, lease or lend the software; or
 - use the software for commercial software hosting services.
- 5. BACKUP COPY.** You may make backup copies of the software. You may use it only to reinstall the software. These backups must only be used by you.
- 6. DOCUMENTATION.** Any person that has valid access to your computer or internal network may copy and use the documentation for your internal, reference purposes only.
- 7. EXPORT RESTRICTIONS.** The software is subject to Australian export laws and regulations. You must comply with all domestic and international export laws and regulations that apply to

the software.

8. **SUPPORT SERVICES.** Because this software is “as is,” we may not provide support services for it.
9. **ENTIRE AGREEMENT.** This agreement (including the warranty below), any addendum or amendment included with the software, and the terms for supplements, updates, Internet-based services and support services that you use, are the entire agreement for the software and support services.
10. **APPLICABLE LAW.**
 - a. **Australian.** If you acquired the software in Australia, Australian interpretation of this agreement and applies to claims for breach of it, regardless of conflict of laws principles. The laws of the Australian state or territory where you live govern all other claims, including claims under state consumer protection laws, unfair competition laws, and in tort.
 - b. **Outside of Australia.** If you acquired the software in any other country, the laws of that country apply.
11. **LEGAL EFFECT.** This agreement describes certain legal rights. You may have other rights under the laws of your state or country. You may also have rights with respect to the party from whom you acquired the software. This agreement does not change your rights under the laws of your state or country if the laws of your state or country do not permit it to do so.
12. **DISCLAIMER OF WARRANTY.** The software is licensed “as-is.” You bear the risk of using it. SystemCORP Embedded Technology gives no express warranties, guarantees or conditions. You may have additional consumer rights under your local laws which this agreement cannot change.
